During the fiscal year to date ended September 30, 2023, the Fund used futures contracts to hedge against changes in market volatility and declines in the value of the Fund's investments and to adjust the Fund's overall equity exposure in an effort to stabilize portfolio volatility around a target level.

At September 30, 2023, the Fund had sufficient cash and/or securities to cover commitments under open derivative contracts.

Affiliated Investments

Fair Value Measurements

U.S. generally accepted accounting principles (U.S. GAAP) establishes a disclosure hierarchy that categorizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to value assets and liabilities at measurement date. These inputs are summarized in the three broad levels listed below:

- Level 1 quoted prices in active markets for identical securities
- Level 2 other significant observable inputs (including quoted prices for similar securities, interest rates, prepayment speeds, credit risk, etc.)
- Level 3 significant unobservable inputs (including the Fund's own assumptions in determining the fair value of investments)

The inputs or methodologies used for valuing securities are not necessarily an indication of the risk associated with investing in those securities.
